

ESSAY AND POSTER CONTESTS

Keep Christ in Christmas Poster Contest

- Grades K through 8 (Ages 5-14)
- Rules:
 - Poster must reflect the theme of "Keep Christ in Christmas."
 - Should be original work (concept, layout, slogan, visual images).
 - Poster should be approximately 11X17 inches.
 - If pastels, charcoal, or chalk are used, poster must be laminated.
 - Poster must be submitted with the Keep Christ in Christmas entry form. (Be sure to include the council number.)
 - Name and age of the entrant should be printed on the back of the poster.
- Judging:
 - Slogan - 30 points (How clearly is the theme presented?)
 - Visuals - 30 points (How well do the visuals convey the theme?)
 - Overall Impact - 40 points (How effective is the poster in capturing your attention and causing you to reflect on the topic?)
- Due Date: Submit council winners in each age category no later than January 31, 2024.

 - Content - 35 points (How clearly is the theme presented?)
 - Grammar - 30 points
 - Style - 35 points
- Due Date: Submit council winners in each grade category no later than January 15, 2024.
